- Network of International Experts

An important aspect of the RockINEurope Project is the creation of a **Network of International Experts** (**NIE**), which is responsible for assembling and preparing a well-revised, generally applicable educational curriculum for teaching Acrobatic Rock'n'Roll.

The international network of experts supervises the results of the project, guaranteeing the efficiency and professional accuracy of the program. When selecting the members of the network, we defined goals, and classified the qualifications and experience of the candidates accordingly. Since the main goal of the project is to prepare a well-revised and generally usable educational curriculum and to create related literature, educational sources, it was essential to assemble a diverse professional team.

Taking the scope and the volume of the Project into consideration, a minimum of 3 (max. 5) experts are essential within the project to provide the required additional professional coverage.

Acrobatic Rock and Roll is a combination of two independent sports: acrobatics and dancing. This means that it requires various fields of expertise. In order to compile the teaching material and any curriculum, several experts with a wide range of expertise must be brought to the board of international experts.

The selection is based on 3 topics:

- DANCING EXPERIENCE OF THE EXPERT
- QUALIFICATIONS, COMPETENCIES, OTHER EXPERTISE
- SPORTS RESULTS AS INSTRUCTOR, TRAINER

In the first round, a limited team of experts from the following countries works together:

Russia, Czech Republic, France, Hungary.

The applications are ongoing, so the team of experts will be expanded in the future.
